Gender Affirmation at Sydney - Students

We want to promote a positive experience for students who are affirming their gender. We've gathered information and support services to assist our trans, gender diverse and non-binary students during their studies at Sydney.

Safer Communities Office

Safer Communities Office are specialist staff experienced in providing an immediate response to students and staff that have experienced sexual misconduct and domestic/family violence, and students who have experienced bullying/harassment and issues relating to modern slavery.



Student Support Liaison Officers (SSLOs)

SSLOs are staff volunteers who have received specialised training to support LGBTQIA+ students, and are members of the LGBTQIA+ communities and allies. SSLOs promote inclusion and support for LGBTQIA+ students at the University and can provide information and resources.

Australian Asexuals

Founded by members of the Sydney asexual social group to represent asexuality at the Sydney Gay and Lesbian Mardi Gras. This group connects asexuals to support resources across Australia.
